- ✓ With many new Education Providers, classes may be held at their location or at the Mon Valley ICD location in Duquesne. Be sure to check your registration confirmation regarding the class location so you arrive on time ...and at the right place!
- ✓ The ICD Policy requires that a minimum of 5 Active USW employees are registered for a class to run. However, there are times when we do not get enough registrations and class may be cancelled. Email updates on cancellations and confirmations are sent within the week prior to the class start.  
One solution to avoid class cancellations; Invite your co-worker to register and attend with you!
- ✓ Some classes have been scheduled in multiple sessions and times per day; this effort is to allow for more participation due to shift work. Contact the ICD Coordinator with any questions on scheduling.
